Fresh fruits, lots of just picked strawberries and red cherries - like opening a tin of fruit salad - amazing. Aromatic and forward, so inviting on the nose. Lovely structure and density, great minerality and tension, really focussed and driving in one line. Feels well made and constructed with some tension but there's juiciness and flesh here too. Ripe and concentrated but fresh and cool with a grip to the tannins and lovely salty finish. Harvest started in the middle of September until October 11. Made with 95% indigenous yeasts from the vineyard. 3.75pH. 50% grand vin production. Yield of 19hl/ha.
